The Parish **Saint Vincent de Paul Society** has 14 members, 6 of whom are auxiliaries who don't attend meetings but visit and / or assist the Conference in various ways. One member, a past President of Leeds Rotary, has continued to raise the profile of St Vincent's Support Centre in Leeds with Rotarians. The result of this much valued work has been contributions to the foodbank and a cash donation of £5,500 in August. Needless to say this has been highly appreciated.

Throughout 2019 SVP members regularly visited 12 clients either in their own homes, in care homes or in hospital. Members also support clients who are wheelchair users on shopping and social outings.

Our Conference usually meets on the **first Monday of the month** (with the odd exception) **at 7pm in the Undercroft**.
