**PARISH DAY PILGRIMAGE:** Tickets are now on sale for our day pilgrimage to the shrines of Our Lady of Mount Grace (Osmotherley) and Blessed Nicholas Postgate (Egton Bridge) on **Bank Holiday Monday (26<sup>th</sup> May)**.
