**LIGHT FOR THE BLIND:** charity is celebrating its 25th Anniversary Year. In 2000, Fr Thomas Rathappillil, a Leeds Diocesan Priest, re-located to his home country of India due to poor health. But he wanted to help those in need. So, he and Myrtle Watkins founded a charity in SE India to test the eyes of the poor where cataracts were prevalent, hence the charity's name. In 2002, the Indian government made cataract operations free for the poor. A new cause was quickly found, helping the destitute and dying. There are now 5 Hospices, all dedicated to St Joseph, with 550 patients. Thankfully, some patients recover but those who do not are cared for and given a dignified funeral. Our parish was one of the first to support this charity as Fr Thomas was a Curate in Morley for a time. Gillian Galek was one of the first Trustees and asked parishioners to contribute pennies to a large whisky bottle kept in the church porch. Our support grew, and for the last few years, more than £1000/year has been sent to Fr Thomas. This sum is raised by the kind donations given at the Sunday Mass coffee service and other donations. Those serving provide all refreshments so all monies can be contributed to the charity. Thank you to all parishioners for supporting this work. A Light for the Blind Christmas newsletter is posted in the narthex.

#### THE BLESSING OF HOMES AT EPIPHANY

20 \* C + M + B \* 26

The following prayer may be said when making the marks:

The Three Wise Men (C) CASPAR, (M) MELCHIOR, and (B) BALTHASAR followed the star of God's Son, who became human (20) two thousand and (26) twenty-six years ago. (\*) May Christ bless (+) our home (+) and remain (+) with us throughout the new year (\*). Amen.

Chalk reminds us of the dust of the earth from which we were made.

The initials CMB stand for the legendary names of the Magi, as well as

CHRISTUS MANSIONEM BENEDICAT (May Christ bless this house)
