CANDLEMAS & ST BLAISE: **Monday (2nd February)** is the Feast of the Presentation of the Lord, when the old man Simeon took Jesus into his arms, gave thanks to God, and declared Him to be '*a light to enlighten the gentiles*'. We will begin the 9.30am Mass at St Joseph's with the traditional blessing of candles, and after Mass our Bethlehem Crib will be put away for another year. **Tuesday (3rd February)** is the Feast of St Blaise, who famously saved a boy from choking to death and so became the patron saint of afflictions of the throat. It is the tradition to use candles that we have blessed the day before to bless our throats, and this will take place after the 7.00pm Mass at St Francis'.
