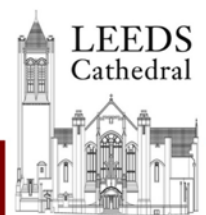

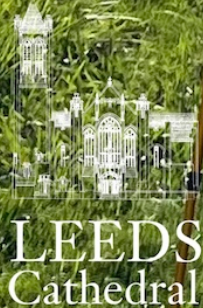
Walk the Leeds Walsingham Way
